SCRIPT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Along with your upline, schedule your Launch at a time that is convenient for you.
- 2.Use our proven scripts on the next page to invite guests. Select the script with which you feel most comfortable.

Practice that script until it feels like your words.

- 3. Decide how many guests you want to have **attend your LAUNCH**.
- 4.Invite and confirm **2x as many guests** as you wish to have attend. (life gets in the way, so typically only 1/2 show up.
- 5.Make the calls. Texts do not work. If the call goes to voicemail, leave the following message: "Hi, _____. This is _____. Please give me a call back. Thanks!" Keep it short and to the point. DO NOT explain why you are calling. Just ask them to give you a call back.
- 6. When you have them on the phone, be direct and to the point. Let them know you have just a few minutes and need to be quick.
- 7. Invite them to your Launch, using the script you selected.
- 8.Be excited-Not pushy. Never convince. Just invite.
- 9.If they say yes, text (or email) info to attend (your address, time and any directions, or the Zoom link and time) to them and let them know you will send a second reminder the day of the event.
